HOW CAN I KEEP MY ADIRONDACK FURNITURE LOOKING LIKE NEW?

Most owners ask about refreshing their beloved Adirondack furniture every year. It is normal for the beautiful Western Red Cedar to fade taking on a greyish patina over time. It is harmless but is simple to reverse in two easy steps.





Put a **small amount of Dawn** dishwashing liquid in a pail of warm water. Using a **soft brush**, clean your furniture with warm soapy water. This will remove the airborne soil and dirt. Rinse it thoroughly and **let it sit for a day or two** so that the wood fibers are dry and will absorb more of the stain/sealer. If desired, use a maroon **3M® Pad** to smooth out any rough areas concentrating especially on the arm rests and fronts of the seats.

DO NOT USE A POWERWASHER ON CEDAR!!!

At this point, you may also use a square drive screwdriver to **tighten any of the stainless-steel screws** that have loosened due to excessive movement or natural shrinkage of the cedar.

Step #2

Using thoroughly mixed **Goof Proof Ready Seal®** <u>liberally</u> apply it to all sides of your pieces using a stain brush or sprayer. **DO NOT WIPE IT OFF.** Rather **let it "rest" for two days** allowing it to be completely absorbed into the wood fibers.

You may now wipe your pieces down taking care to get the undersides of the seat and arm rests on chairs free from any residual stain.
